

Rules For Safe Camping

- 1. Drive carefully and slowly 10 miles per hour, WATCH FOR CHILDREN!
- 2. Keep your campsite clean. Pick up your trash and place it in the dumpster.
- 3. 10:00 P.M. is quiet time. Please quiet your campsite at that time so other campers are not disturbed.
- 4. Pets must be walked in designated pet areas. They are to be kept on a leash, not allowed to run loose.
- 5. Do not park vehicles on the grass. We will help you find safe parking for your vehicles.
- 6. Respect other people's campsites, walk around them rather than through when going to the pool, play areas, etc.
- 7. There is no lifeguard on duty. Parents must be responsible for their own swimmers. Swimmers must not dive, splash dive, or dunk other swimmers. No glass containers in pool area.
- 8. No running in pool area.
- 9. Check out time: 11:00 A.M.
- 10. Camper washing is allowed with buckets and brushes only no hoses.
- 11. Enjoy your stay.
